Critical Areas covered this year:

Grading Policy:

Homework (5 points each)– Homework is so important to reinforce class work. This is a weekly grade. Points vary based on the number of homework assignments given each week.

Tests – Point values for each written test will vary based on the number of questions/problems on the test. Tests will include matching, multiple choice problems, word problems, and standard numerical operations.

Quizzes – Quizzes will be given periodically and will vary in total points. We will start the year with a series of multiplication and division quizzes.

Projects – Projects will vary in total points. The goal is to show my students that math is applicable in the real world and all projects I assign will reflect that. Projects will count as either a test grade or quiz grade depending on the project.

Exams – We will have an exam at the end of the 2nd quarter and at the end of the 4th quarter. Each exam will be worth two test grades.
